A play is a story acted out on stage

The actors are pretending to be characters.

The actors will say what they are thinking or feeling.

The actors will pretend to show different emotions—happiness, sadness, or anger.



LOCATION CHANGES

The backdrop and set will remain the same during the performance.

The location of play action will change without a change in the backdrop.

The characters will share text-based clues to indicate a change of location.

Some of the locations are: The school cafeteria, the glen, and the school dance.



FOOD FIGHT

The bugs and fairies get into a food fight.

They pretend to throw food at each other.

There is no real food being thrown.

Even though they are fighting, they are also having fun.



COSTUMES

All of the characters in the show are either fairies or bugs.

The fairy costumes have fairy wings.

The bugs are not dressed to look like bugs.

There are text-based clues and some costume pieces that let us know what bug each character represents.
